He received the “Doctorat d’Etat” in physics in 1985 from Institut National Polytechnique de Grenoble (INPG).

- From 1986 to 1993 he was member of the Centre National de la Recherche Scientifique (CNRS).
- From 1993 to 1996 he was professor at the Joseph Fourier University of Grenoble. Since 1996 he is professor at the ESISAR an engineer school of INPG. Professor S. Tedjini is in charge of lectures in applied electromagnetism, radiofrequency and optoelectronics, for undergraduate, graduate and PhD students.
- He also has a large experience in continuing education lectures.
- He acts as responsible and/or manager of several education projects at the INPG. Professor S. Tedjini conducts research in microwave, guided optics and high speed optoelectronics.
- His actual interest concerns RF Wireless and optoelectronic systems. Professor Tedjini supervised 19 PhD thesis and authored/coauthored more than 200 scientific papers and communications.
- He is member of several reviewing committees and scientific societies (IEEE Senior Member, Chapter Chair of French CPMT/IEEE, Vice-president for France at CNFRS/URSI commission D, French societies SEE, EEA).
